

A Regular Meeting of the Board of Delta County Road Commissioners was held on Tuesday, May 11, 2021 at 4:30 p.m. at the Main Office, 3000 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue North, Escanaba, Michigan. The Board Meeting was accessible to the public via GoToMeeting Conference Call.
