

July 26, 2022

A Regular Meeting of the Board of Delta County Road Commissioners was held on Tuesday, July 26, 2022, at 3:30 p.m. at the Main Office, 3000 32nd Avenue North, Escanaba, Michigan.

Vice-Chairman Bjork called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

PRESENT: Vice-Chairman Randy Bjork, Commissioner Dennis Stanek and Commissioner Mark Asselin. Commissioner Dustin Stempki was present via phone.

ABSENT: Chairman Bob Aschbacher

Vice-Chairman Bjork moved to approve the agenda as printed.

Vice-Chairman Bjork moved to approve the minutes of the July 12, 2022, Regular Meeting as proposed.

Manager Jody Norman gave a brief admin update:

Jody explained that the current bill pay includes sealcoat billings along with gravel & chip processing costs, which will benefit the Road Commission for future years. On the MDOT system there have been a large volume of phone calls regarding the construction near Whitefish River Bridge in Rapid River, which is an MDOT project, not a Road Commission project. The crew has been working in Iron Mountain on storm sewers for MDOT. On the county road system, the crew has been sweeping, hauling gravel & finishing up projects. Jody gave a summary of the meeting held in Mount Pleasant regarding the ongoing deer issue: 13 counties along with the CRA attended & there was productive discussion with a lot of good ideas and thoughts. The 911 committee has completed going through Cornell Township and will present it to the County Board & the Townships next. Jody also informed the Board of a dump truck auction purchase to replace the one currently being used on the AMZ machine.

It was moved by Commissioner Asselin, seconded by Commissioner Stanek to approve Bills Payable Voucher No. 2602 in the amount of \$1,166,107.28 & Payroll Voucher No. 69162 in the amount of \$92,200.94.
