

Minutes of Regular Meeting at Kipling Hall

Brampton Township

June 17, 2024

Supervisor Maufort called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The pledge was cited by attendees consisting of all Board members and visitors Pat Young, John Malnar, Craig Pelosa, Ashley Edwardsen and Tony and Priscilla Hall.

M/Elegeert S/Thull approving the May minutes. M/C

Public attendees Tony and Priscilla Hall asked the board if the Township had any type of ordinance or addressed short term rentals within the Township. Supervisor Maufort stated there is nothing at this time.

John Malnar informed the group he was elected Chair of the County Commission. He attended the CMHA conference and they are still working to get some funds for mental health in the area.

Supervisor Maufort informed the board Dottie LaJoie from CUPPAD would be attending our July meeting with her recreation plan presentation.

Clerk Edwardsen asked who was responsible for cutting down trees along the roadside in residents' yards. Supervisor Maufort said it was the owner's responsibility.

The election commission meeting was scheduled for July 15, 2024 at 6:30 pm.

Fire Chief Young reported 3 call outs – all for trees down on power lines.

Department volunteers did mutual aid training with Baldwin, Tri-Township, Escanaba Township and the City of Gladstone.

Fire Chief Young asked the board about the department filling swimming pools.

M/Thull S/Elegeert for the department to fill pools ONLY for Township residents.

Clerk Edwardson informed the group of the following:

- The inside hall door knob to the lift was replaced.
- The door knob to the basement storage room needs to be replaced.
- Public testing for the August 6th election is scheduled for July 16, 2024 at 6:00 pm.
- Peninsula Federal Credit Union Credit cards for the fire department were opened and handed out for use in the fire trucks.

Treasurer Thull reported getting the 2024 Metro check for \$5,649.18 which included the underpayment from last year of \$2,093.07. She has all prior tax documents turned into equalization and is expecting summer taxes coming soon.
