Any changes to the proposed earth change activities made to the project after submission of permit application must be presented to and approved by the soil erosion control officer before the changes have been started.

Obtaining a soil erosion control permit does not preclude the need for additional local, state or federal permits. It is the landowner's responsibility to ensure all permits are secured.

The project must be staked before the soil erosion officer can inspect the proposed earth change activities and issue the soil erosion control permit.

The soil erosion officer has 30 days to review the presented application, but typically the permit can be issued between 5 – 10 business days.

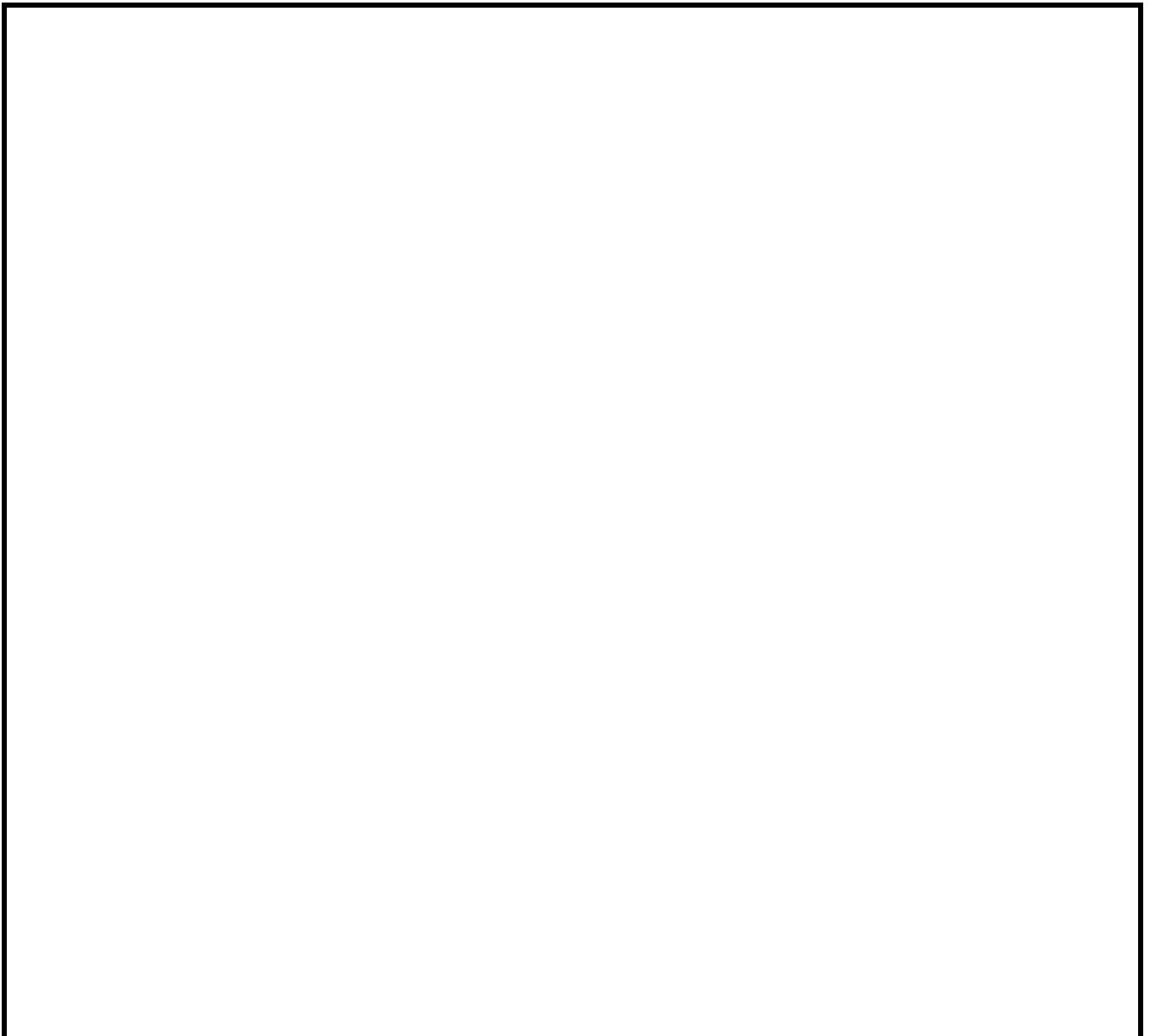

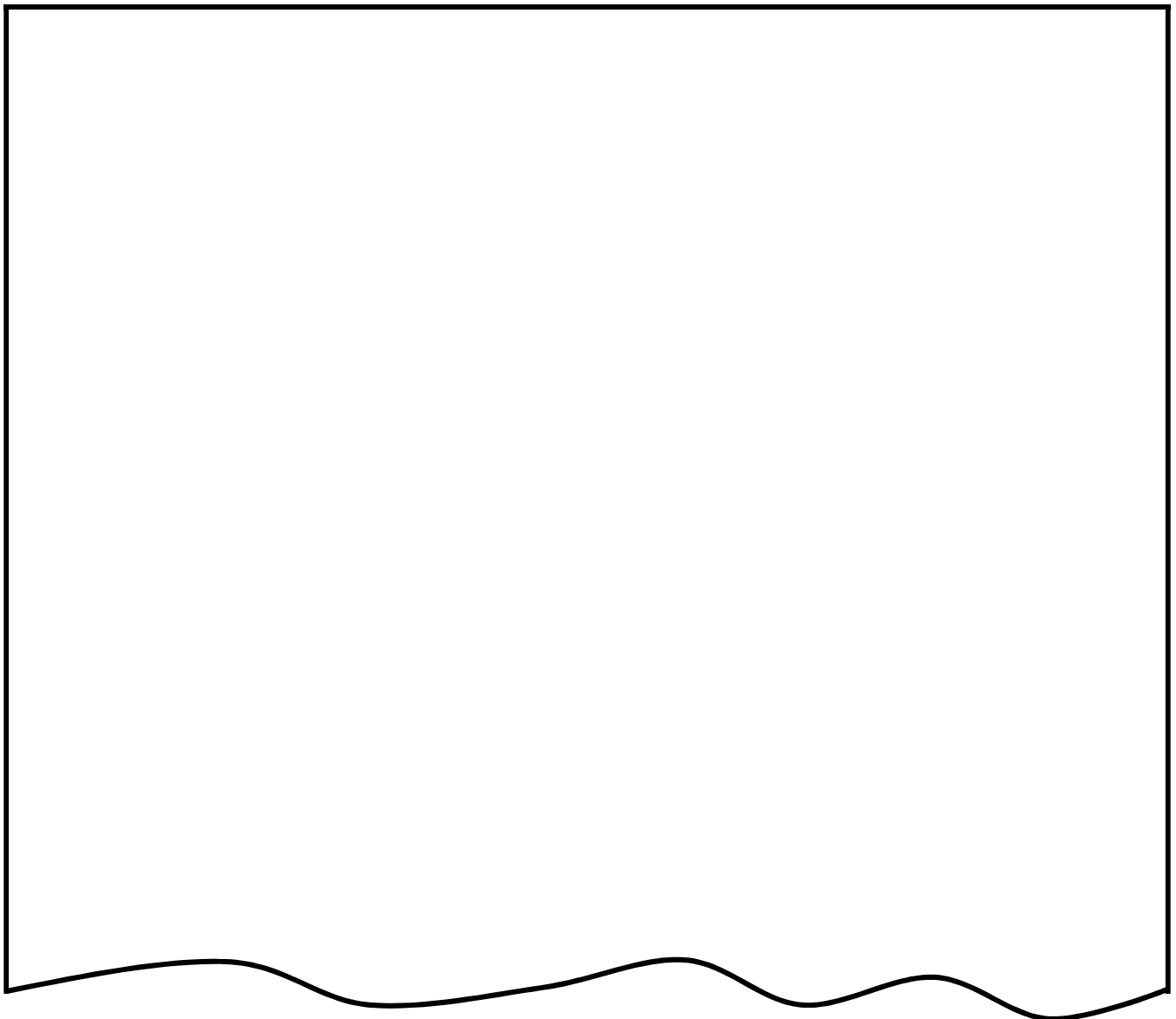
